

Chapter 27

Zero and Nine in Non-Dualistic Thought

Let us try to find the sum of some counting numbers whether they are small or large numbers.

Eg:

$28 + 365 + 6 + 72 = 471$. Then find the sum of the digits of 471. $4 + 7 + 1 = 12$.

Again find the sum of digits in 12. ie $1 + 2 = 3$.

The same operation can be done in another way.

28, 365, 6, 72 are the numbers we chose to find the sum. $2 + 8 + 3 + 6 + 5 + 7 + 2 = 39$.

Again repeat the process. $3 + 9 = 12$. Doing it once again

$1 + 2 = 3$.

All the numbers support this two methods whatever be their value.

Therefore, let us find the sum of numbers from 1 up to 9 which represents the infinite counting numbers (Compound numbers).

$1 + 2 + 3 + \dots + 9 = 45$. The sum of the digits of 45 is 9.

So we understand that all the numbers up to infinity dissolved in the digit 9. Ie the destination of all the numbers is 9 or all the counting numbers focus on 9. This is why 9 is referred to as the number indicating Christ in numerology.

The set of numbers extending to infinity consists of numbers indicating the angels, the holy deities and the Snakes of fire. All the infinite creatures of God will be represented by any one of the infinite numbers. Remember the holy words of Christ that the number of hairs of the human beings are known to God.

Suppose all the numbers in our imagination focus on 9 and dissolved in 9. Then anything else remaining? 'No' will be the answer. But that answer is wrong. Zero remains there. It always seen on the left side of 9. ie 09. ie 9 positions in the right side of Zero.

The number '0' indicates infinity and eternity. It is a self emptying number. It is another form of love. We can think that $0 = \heartsuit$. We can write 09 as $\heartsuit 9$.

The number zero(0) representing infinity, eternity and love indicates God. $\heartsuit 9$ indicate the severe relationship between Christ and God.

There a question arises. Zero has no value!!! Do we belittle God by representing God by zero?. It is a big blunder to think that zero has no value. I think zero is the most valuable number because all the numbers originating from zero and hence it can be called as the treasure of numbers.

For this reason, zero is considered as father and mother of all the numbers. There is no such a valuable number. So we can not find the value of zero. Any big number can be originated from it. Since we can not find its value, we conveniently skip away by saying 'Zero doesn't have any value'.

Zero is the alpha (α) and omega (Ω) in the number system. We have already seen that zero represents infinity and eternity. The infinity and eternal peculiarity teaches us that the first and the last number in the number system is zero.

' $1=10=0$ ' is a fundamental law in numerology. But we can not prove it through valid mathematical solving methods. From the above equation, we can realize that zero is greater than any number and also stands equivalent with every number. It is obvious that since all numbers originate from zero, no number has power and influence more than zero possesses.

$0 > 1,2,3,4,\dots,\alpha$.

But while comparing counting numbers, we can assume that $1 < 2$, $2 < 3$ etc. all these description about zero are ideological. So those can not be compared with mathematical laws .

09 was our point of discussion. Let us write 0 separately.

0

then the infinite numbers dissolved in 9 regenerate from 0 without any change in their values.

0 $1,2,3,\dots,\alpha$.

But we can understand that zero is an invisible companion with each and every number.

0 $01, 02, \dots, 0100, \dots, 04789, \dots, 0\alpha$.

Just like '0' stands invisible with all numbers, God travels invisible with man, precisely assessing his activities, without any discrimination. That is why, the spiritual masters say that God's immortality is with everybody.

Count Louis Hamon, one famous western numerologist resolved '9' in another way and explained how '9' represents Christ. We will see how it is.

Multiply 9 with any small or large counting number.

Eg.

$9 \times 21 = 189$.

$1+8+9=18$.

$1+8=9$.

The number 189 go back to 9 itself. This is a method in which only multiples of 9 coming back to 9.

But in the beginning of this chapter, we see all the numbers originating from zero whether they are small or large focus on 9 according to the said calculation. If we compare 9 with Christ and multiples of 9 with Christians, then we get an idea that only Christians can achieve Christ.

But if we adopt the method mentioned in the beginning of this chapter for resolving 9, then that will lead us to the non-dualistic thought apart from Christians, all the believers of all the religions can achieve Christ without changing their religion. It doesn't mean that the method of Count Louis Hamon is wrong. It is also a good method.

The destination of all numbers is 9. And hence 9 represents Christ. Zero indicates infinity and eternity.

Since all the numbers originating from zero, it is the most dominant and noblest number and for the same reason, zero is the father as well as the mother of all numbers. As any large number can be originated from zero, the value of zero is greater than any number. So zero stands as the first and last in the number system indicating infinity[α and Ω].

Zero is the number which exists invisible and self emptying with every number. Like this, the number representing God is zero and the one representing Christ is 9. My statement zero is greater than all the numbers is purely ideological. So I don't have to argue with mathematicians. The meaning of the word 'Poojyam' (A word in Sanskrit-means zero) means to be worshipped, to be consecrated, etc. The reason for that may be due to the fact that it represents God.

Once, one of my friends, Mr. Shivaraman Nair happened to read this chapter. He didn't hesitate to say jokes teasing me. He said, ' Dear friend. My child has zero mark for all the subjects in the examination. What do you say?'. I replied in the same coin 'Surely your son is brilliant. Encourage him to get zeros in the coming examinations also. But remember one thing, zero is deserved by God only. Those who try to get it won't survive long. Bible says (Isaiah 42:8) that God won't give His glory to anybody. So it's better for your son to try for another number leaving zero free'.
